We are looking for adults with GERD between the ages of 22 to 74 years old to participate in our GERD treatment study. Our research study investigates how well the Omega device functions in treating GERD.

ABOUT THE OMEGA TREATMENT

The simple Omega device is laparoscopically placed partially around the esophagus to decrease and prevent acid reflux. The Omega is designed to minimize common troublesome side effects such as difficulty swallowing for a better patient experience.

The Omega implant procedure will be performed by world-class surgical teams at no cost to the participants.

STUDY VISIT INFORMATION

- The study will last for 12 months or a little longer.
- After the device implant procedure, there will be 6-8 follow-up visits every several months.
- You will receive a stipend for completing each follow-up visit.



ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

- You are between 22 and 74 years old.
- · You have GERD symptoms.
- You have tried proton pump inhibitor (PPI) medications with improvement.
- You are generally healthy and there are other eligibility requirements to meet.
